Six Classes of Entry:

Youth & Adult: Youth 17 years or younger with adult over 18 years of age.

Adult 18 and over: Both entrants are over 18 years of age.

Solo: Must be over 18 years of age.

Adult 50+: Over 50 years of age.

3 Person Relay: A team effort of any combination, but one person in water craft must be over 18 years of age.

T-Shirt Size: M L XL

Note: Helmets are mandatory for the bike portion and PFD's are mandatory for the paddle.

Two person teams: Time will start/stop when both racers cross the start/finish line.

Three person relay: Each racer will complete one leg of the race. Time will stop when the bike crosses the finish line.

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
